And had it not 4 corners

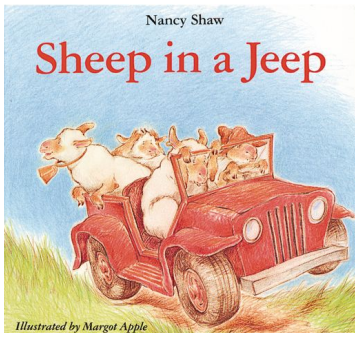
It would not be my scarf
