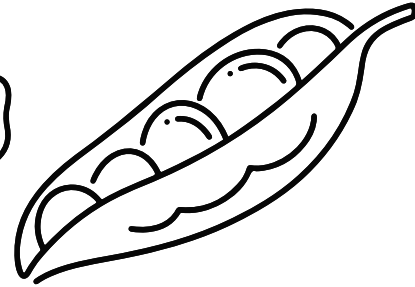
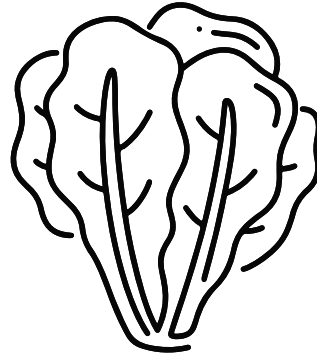
Growing a Garden

There are lots of colors in the garden! Color in the following plants and flowers. Do you know all their names?

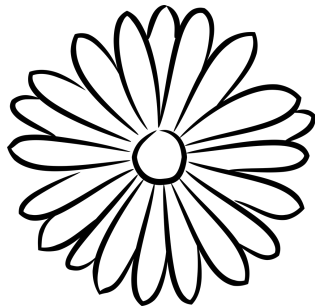
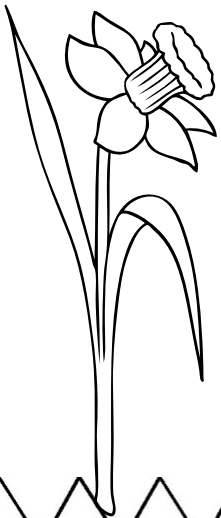
